Ordinance 2019-01

An ordinance of the Town of Lee, Florida levying the ad valorem property tax millage rate for municipal purposes on all taxable property within the Town for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018, and ending September 30, 2019, stating the percentage by which the millage to be levied is less than the rolled-back rate; and providing an effective date.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LEE OF MADISON COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019/2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
